The optimal guideline level of LDL cholesterol is less than 100 mg/dl. Research from the Cleveland Clinic (REVERSAL study) compared two cholesterol lowering drugs (pravastatin and atorvastatin) and found that lower levels of LDL, as low as 60 mg/dl had better outcomes.

Overview of Clinical Guidelines in Lipid Management

2013 ACC/AHA Cholesterol Guidelines: Summary 1) Heart healthy lifestyle habits are the foundation to CVD prevention 2) Assess 10-year CVD risk every 4-6 years in adults 40-75 y/o and w/o CVD, DM, not yet on lipid therapy and w/ LDL 70-189 mg/dl 3) Recommend high-intensity statin in those with CVD and age <75 years (statin categ 1)

In conclusion, this guideline document aims to simplify cholesterol management through the identification of specific patient subgroups that would derive benefit from statin therapy (established ASCVD, an LDL-C level of ≥ 190 mg/dL, or a history of type 1 or 2 diabetes) and then refines risk assessment for the rest of the population by the use of a global CVD risk calculator.

The cholesterol guidelines from the American College of Cardiology and American Heart Association have been updated for the first time since 2013. Notably, target cholesterol levels have been returned to the guidelines for people in specific circumstances, to be achieved through medications and lifestyle changes.

The 2013 ACC/AHA guidelines eliminated low-density lipoprotein cholesterol (LDL-C) and non-high-density lipoprotein cholesterol (non-HDL-C) as goals of therapy and replaced them with the concept of 4 "statin benefit groups"—that is, patient populations for which clear evidence supports the role of statin therapy. 4 In the 2018 guideline, statin benefit groups have been maintained, although without explicit use of this term. 1

In summary, the 2013 ACC/AHA Lipid Guideline primarily focuses on statin treatment in four major at risk groups with the goal of preventing primary or secondary heart attack, stroke or death. This guideline focuses on the use of standard fixed-dose statin therapy as the means to improve cardiovascular outcomes in patients with ASCVD as opposed to targeting specific LDL-C goals.
