Prince Rupert was born in Prague in 1619, during the reign (of a single winter’s duration) of his parents, the King and Queen of Bohemia. This portrait was painted after the family had been driven into exile in the Dutch Republic (Frederick V of Bohemia was nephew of the Dutch Stadtholder, Maurice of Nassau, Prince of Orange).
