Scale implies that is it a scaled down version of the real thing. O scale used to be called 1/4 inch scale with the ratio to the real thing as 1:48 with HO being 1/8 inch scale and 1:86 or 1:87. That makes it simple except that there have been some subtle changes in HO and it is now 3.5 mm and 1:87.1.

HO scale is 1:87 scale, where 3.5 millimeters in the model represents one foot in the real thing. The track gauge is 16.5 millimeters wide, or .65 inches. The other standard to emerge from these early efforts, OO scale, is slightly larger, at 1:76 scale.

HO or H0 is a rail transport modelling scale using a 1:87 scale. It is the most popular scale of model railway in the world. The rails are spaced 16.5 mm apart for modelling 1,435 mm standard gauge tracks and trains in HO. The name HO comes from 1:87 scale being half that of O scale, which was previously the smallest of the series of older and larger 0, 1, 2 and 3 gauges introduced by Märklin around 1900. For instance, HO scale models are 1/87th the size of the real thing. If you had an HO scale model of a forty-foot boxcar, you would need 87 of them to match the length of the real thing. The distance between the rails is called the gauge. In the real world, "standard gauge" is four feet, eight and a half inches inside-to-inside between the rails.

What is an HO scale model? An HO scale model train is about 1/87 scale to a real life train, and your scenery and accessories will fit the same scale. You can hold a locomotive or car in one hand comfortably without fully covering it (which is more likely to be N scale). Using two hands to hold one might indicate a G or O scale model.

Scale is the ratio of a model dimension to the real life dimension. O Scale in the UK is commonly 1:43.5 or 7 mm to the foot, in continental Europe it is commonly 1:45 though 1:43.5 is also used particularly in France, and in the USA 1:48. Each region tends to design models to its own scale.
